Trash Management in Bear Country

Positioned near National Wild Life Refuge Land, Scenic Lakes is frequented by bears and other wildlife, who have gotten very creative at finding successful ways to get into the garbage. Whether you chose to use a service above or visit the Sussex County Municipal Authority (34 NJ-94, Lafayette, NJ 07848) on your own, **all community members have a responsibility to manage their trash.** While bearproof cans may do the job for the hours before morning pickup, members are encouraged find alternative methods of storage (sheds, garages, etc.) to ensure that garbage is not broken into & strewn through the community. Should you opt into a garbage pick-up service, members are required to remove their cans from the street side after garbage service.
